Contestants invited to the Live Round should be prepared to play selections from their recorded submission and from three Hugo Kauder Solo Works of their choice: one Sonata (1, 2, 3, or 4), the Toccata in E (1952 Revision), and any Prelude and Fugue. Competition judges will be Claude Frank, Yale School of Music and Curtis Institute of Music; Pamela Frank, Peabody Institute of the Johns Hopkins University and Stony Brook; and Peter Frankl, Yale School of Music.
